Ground Rules for patrons of all ages

- 1. The Library is not a playground. It is for quiet play or reading books. Games such as hide and seek must be played outside.
- 2. At the Library, please use your indoor voice.
- 3. No running. Shoes must stay on at the Library.
- 4. Please be respectful of Library property and toys. Please clean up the toys when you are through.
- 5. No screaming please.
- 6. All children under the age of nine (9) must be accompanied by an adult.

Storytime Rules

If you are here for Storytime:

- 1. We expect that you will sit quietly and listen to the story, or play QUIETLY while the leader reads.
- 2. Parents and caregivers are expected to pay attention to their children at all times, as well as monitor their behavior. Please do not talk during the stories.

Outdoor Play

- 1. If you would like to play outside, you **must** take your parent or caregiver. Parents, please do not stay downstairs if your child is going outside. Route 123 is busy!
- 2. The Library does not have a water fountain. Please bring closable water bottles.
- 3. Climbing on the building is not permitted.

Please understand that, in order to ensure that all patrons continue to enjoy the library, you will be asked to leave if these rules are not followed.
